Lasting Powers of Attorney

Whilst we all want to stay healthy, independent and able to make our own decisions, the fact is that there may come a time when we are no longer physically or mentally as able as we were.

Whilst many make provision in a Will as to what is to happen should they die, fewer take steps to provide for what should happen if they are unable to deal with financial and other issues on their own.

Of course, it is not just about being unable to manage as a result of old age. Many things can happen to you including accidents, illness or mental health problems.

The simplest way to ensure that your affairs continue to be dealt with at a time when you cannot do so is by making a **Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA)**.

There are two types of LPA:

- ❖ **A property and finance power** which lets you appoint someone to make financial decisions on your behalf, and
- ❖ **A health and welfare power** which lets you choose someone to make decisions about medical treatment, accepting and refusing healthcare or whether to move into residential accommodation

Probate and Estate Administration
